Physical Development

To show some control when using scissors

Hold pencil near point between first two fingers and thumb and uses it with good control

Manage toileting and washing hands independently

Copy some letters from name

Personal Social & Emotional Development

Shows confidence when asking for help

Usually adapt behaviour to different events, social situations and changes in routine

Initiates conversations and forms good relationships with peers

Understanding the World

To share and talk about significant events in their own lives

Develop an understanding of growth, decay and changes over time

Beginning to use some technological equipment independently

Literacy

Know that print is read from left to right and top to bottom in English

To give meaning to marks they draw and paint

Begin to link some letters and their sounds in their name

Mathematics

Show and interest in representing number in a variety of ways

To match some numerals and amounts to 10

Begin to talk about the shapes of everyday objects, e.g. 'round and tall'

Communication & Language

Able to focus attention- still listen or do, but can shift own attention

Beginning to understand and answer 'why' and 'how' questions

Use a range of tenses when talking

Expressive Arts & Design

Join construction pieces together to build and balance and create representations of things and spaces

Captures experiences and responses with a range of media, such as music, dance, paint and other materials or words
