We are learning to...



Physical Development

Put on our own coat independently.

Use scissors to snip, then cut in a straight line.

Negotiate space successfully, negotiating speed or direction to avoid obstacles.

Communication & Language

Join in with repeated refrains and anticipates key events in rhymes and stories.

Show an understanding of positional language e.g. under, over, behind.

Ask questions and give explanations.

Expressive Arts & Design

Use various construction materials.

Build stories around toys.

Express ourselves creatively through art, dance and music.

Personal Social & Emotional Development

Play in a group, responding to others and sharing ideas.

Choose the resources needed for an activity.

Understand the need to take turns.

Understanding the World

Use different icons to create pictures on the interactive whiteboard.

Show an interest in different occupations.

Comment and ask questions about the world around us.

Literacy

Listen and join in with stories and poems.

Copy writing patterns and shapes that will help us to form letters.

Recognising familiar words (e.g. their name)

Explore different purposes for mark-making, including looking for print in our environment.

Mathematics

Count and compare quantities of objects.

Recognise numbers and start to use a number line when counting.

Compare two groups of objects.

Talk about the size and shape of everyday objects.
