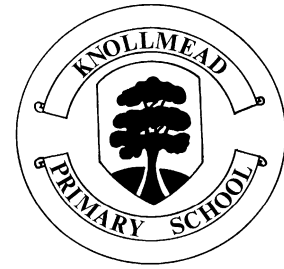


Knollmead Primary School
