

# Understanding Bar Models

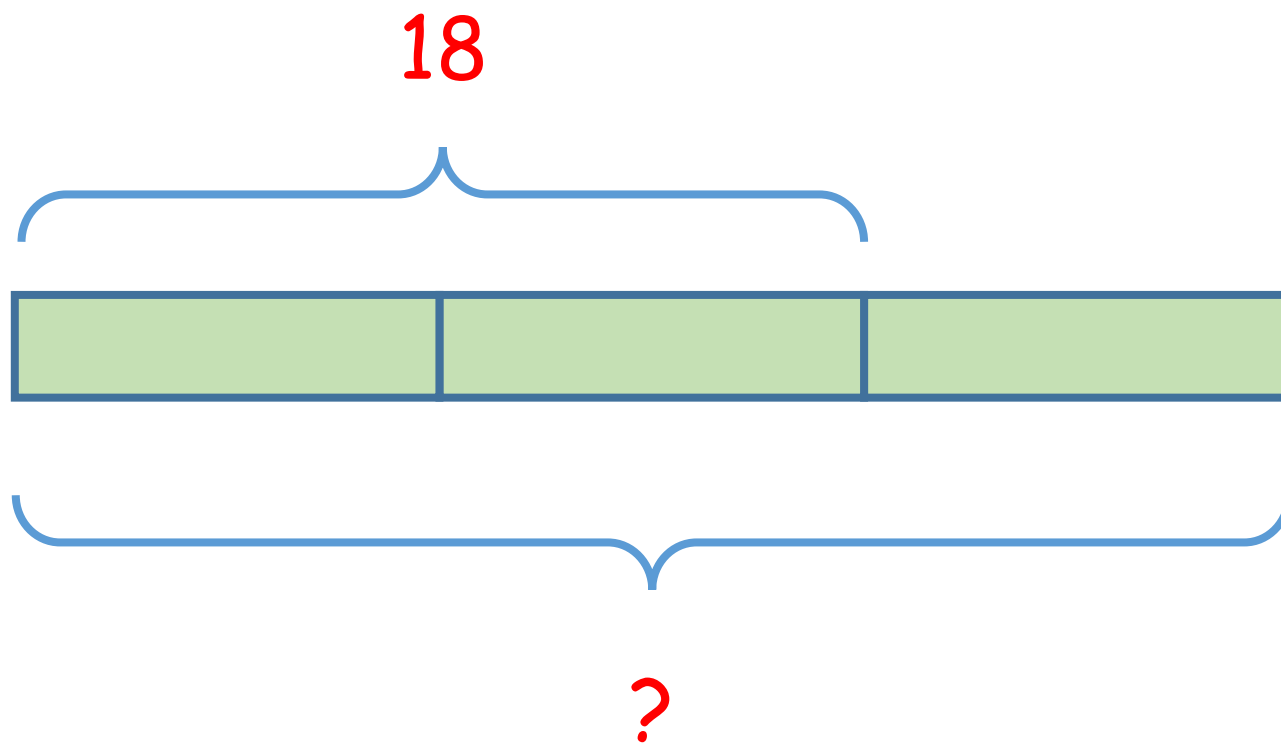
Each question has a diagram made up of a number of different coloured rectangles, each with a width of 1.

To answer the question you must use the information given, to work out the value of the question mark (?).

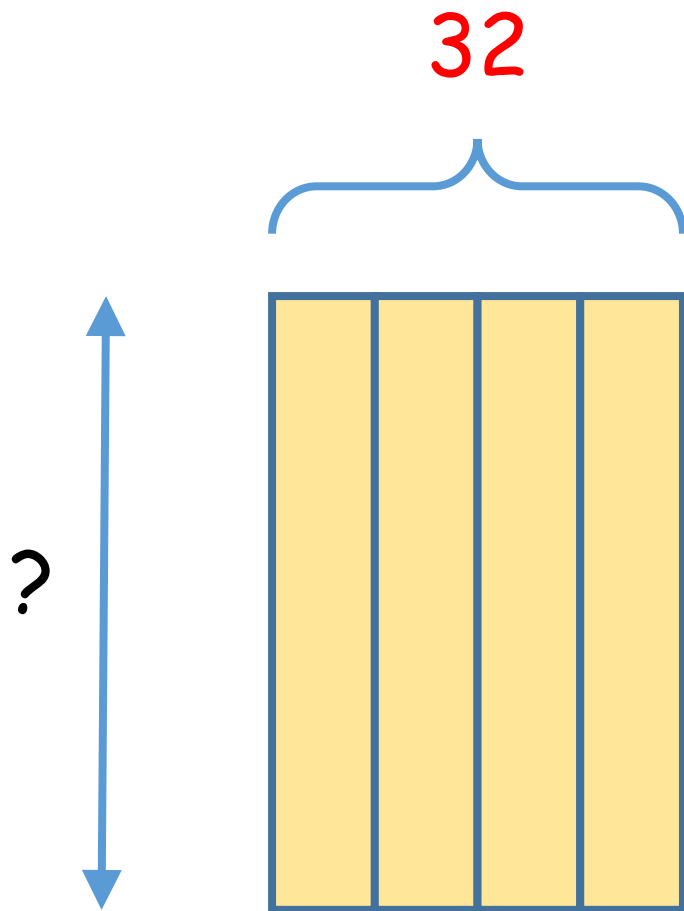
The information you have been given is either

- or an area (in red) indicated by a curly bracket.

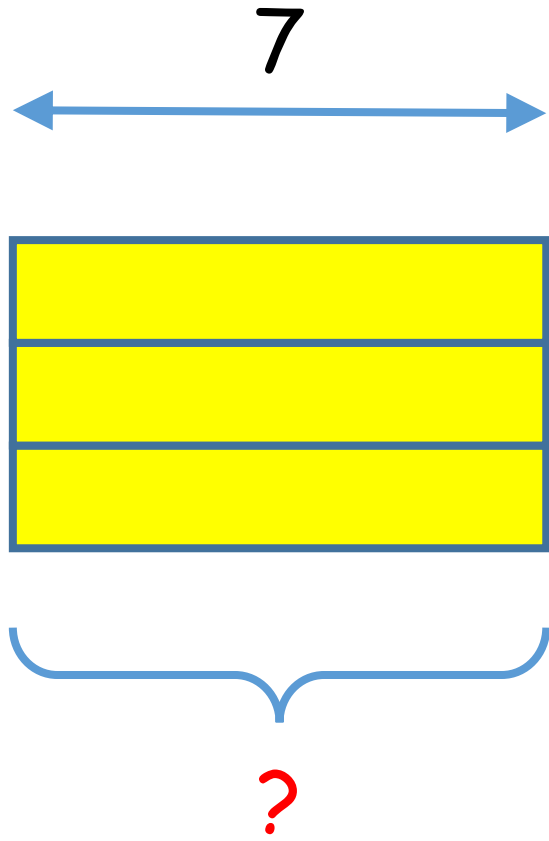
